## **History Day Mentor for Coaches**

If you are considering starting a History Day program at your school, or are just looking for ways to improve your existing program, consider reaching out to a *History Day Mentor for Coaches*.

## What does a History Day Mentor for Coaches do?

A *History Day Mentor for Coaches* is a teacher who has successfully participated in the History Day program, often for many years. They understand the ins and outs of the program and are willing to answer your coaching-related questions via email and/or telephone. A mentor can teach you about a specific issue or coach you on a particular skill. They may help facilitate your growth by sharing resources and networks or may challenge you to move beyond your comfort zone.

Your mentor may suggest ways and strategies to:

- solicit support and funds for your program from administrators, fellow teachers, and parents;
- develop your school/district program (in-class assignment vs. after-school program);
- implement Common Core in your History Day efforts;
- guide students in selecting categories and topics that match their skills and interests;
- find History Day resources online;
- understand the judging process and characteristics of winning History Day entries;
- prepare students and parents on what to expect the day of competition; and
- help you prepare to guide your students as they advance to the next round.

## What does a History Day Mentor for Coaches not do?

- Mentors should NOT review, edit, or judge your students' projects.
